“ThyssenKrupp Elevator (China) Awarded Biggest Order Ever” Chongqing Branch to install 405 elevators in the city of Guiyang

ThyssenKrupp Elevator (China) Chongqing Branch has signed a contract for 405 elevators to be installed in the Guiyang Mountain and Water City in Guiyang City, capital of the Guizhou Province in China's south west.

It is the biggest contract (unit wise) ThyssenKrupp Elevator (China) has ever won.

The order includes 65 x units of LEV home lifts with a speed of 0.2 m/s, 300 x units of TE-B elevators with a speed of 1.75 m/s and a travel height of 80 metres, and 40 x Evolution machine room-less elevators with a speed of 1.60 m/s.

This ecologically built development has the theme of "green mountains, clear water and blue sky" and while developing the regional economy, will continue to sustain the city's ecological environment and improving the overall quality of the surrounding areas.

Included in the development of Guiyang Mountain and Water City are villas, luxury apartments, shopping centres and schools.

The first phase of the elevator installation will start will start on March 30 2006 with 12 x elevators ready for use by April 2006. All other installations will be completed in the next 2 to 3 years.

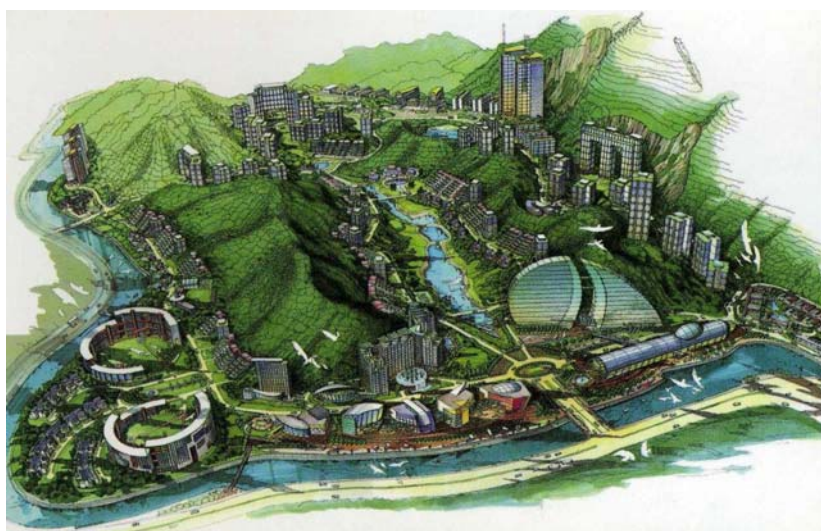
